- 2. Devotions Pastor Cook
 - We often need reminders that Jesus is content to call disciples to just watch and pray.

- 3. Financial Report Darren Doehrmann
 - For the month of April, we had a deficit of \$1,774. Total giving was \$64,658, which was about \$400 less than budgeted. The giving income needed each month would be \$60,833 if divided equally throughout the year.
 - For the fiscal year, we have a surplus of \$80,377. Cumulative, we have a \$53,592 surplus.
- 4. Fiscal Year 2022-23 Budget Approval Darren Doehrmann
 - Darren motioned to approve Fiscal Year 2022-23 Budget, Larry Ashley seconded
 - Discussion about budget:
 - Highlights as budget stood after separate budget meeting
 - 4.1% increase over previous giving
 - School revenue is on par with prior budget
 - Expecting a \$80k surplus from current year to be carried over
 - Increasing District tithe from 7% to 10%
 - Salaried from 93% to 95% of midpoint
 - Hourly workers 4.0% increase
 - Total exp 1.7M rev 1.701M, currently in the positive \$1600. Budget to be balanced by the Voters' Assembly Meeting.
 - Dave called for the question approved unanimously
